

ANNEXURE A

Requirements for AHAA Recognition of Independent Horse Archery Instructors



- (1) Under this rule an Instructor will be recognised by AHAA as a recommended instructor for teaching the sport of Horse Archery providing they have the following:
- (a) Current and valid Instructor Indemnity Insurance stating Horse Archery on the policy.
 - (b) Current HSA (Horse Safety Australia) or EA (Equestrian Australia) recognised RIDING INSTRUCTOR certificate or equivalent from a recognised Australian government institution.
 - (c) Be a current financial member of AHAA and agree to uphold the rules of the Association.
 - (d) Hold an IHAA (International Horseback Archery Alliance) S6 Grading or higher.

As an AHAA recognised instructor they are able to promote their business via AHAA's electronic media assets.
